This position requires a strong commitment to teaching legal research skills essential to the practice of law, a deep understanding of the Law School's curriculum, faculty research interests, library operations, legal information resources, and research methodologies in all formats. An MLS from an ALA accredited institution or an equivalent relevant advanced degree and a JD from an ABA accredited institution are required for this position. Salary range for this position is \$75,000 - \$81,000.
